Eligibility Criteria: L.L.B. Degree

Age Limitation: Minimum 23 years and Maximum 35 years

SC/ST: Up to 40 years Candidate of West Bengal only

Backward Class: Up to 38 years

COMPULSORY PAPER:

1. English Composition, Essay, and Precis Writing
2. Bengali / Hindi / Urdu / Nepali composition, Essay and Translation from English into Bengali / Hindi / Urdu / Nepali
3. General Knowledge and Current Affairs
4. Civil Procedure Code
5. Criminal Procedure Code
6. Indian Penal Code
7. Indian Evidence Act
8. Law of Contracts
9. Law of Torts
10. Transfer of Property Act





WEST BENGAL STATE JUDICIARY SYLLABUS

OPTIONAL PAPER:

Candidates shall take up any three of the following topics:

- 1) Hindu Law
- 2) Muslim Law
- 3) Jurisprudence and principles of legislation
- 4) Indian law relating to companies and Insurance
- 5) Principles of Equity including the Law of Trusts and Specific Relief
- 6) Partnership Act
- 7) Law of Limitation and Law of Prescription
- 8) Indian Constitution and Constitutional Law

Each of the compulsory and optional papers carries 100 marks and is of 3 hours duration.

Note: The standard of examination in the law paper (compulsory and optional) will be that of the L.L. B. degree of the Calcutta University. All answers must be written either in English or in Bengali (unless otherwise directed in question papers) except in the language paper.
